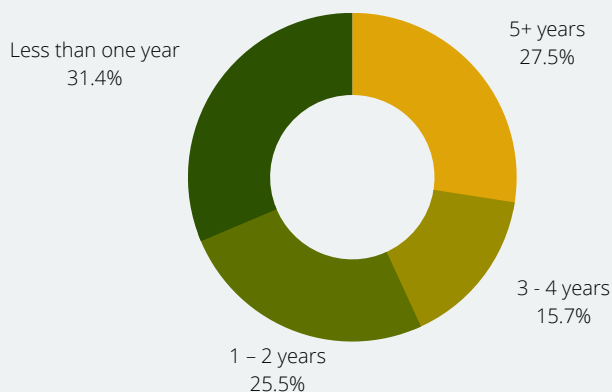

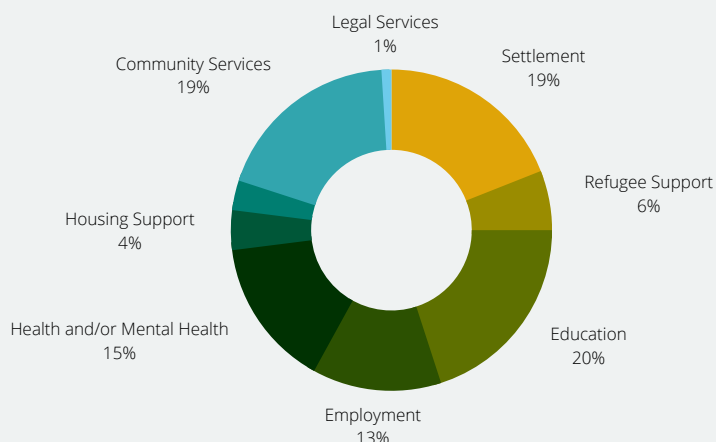

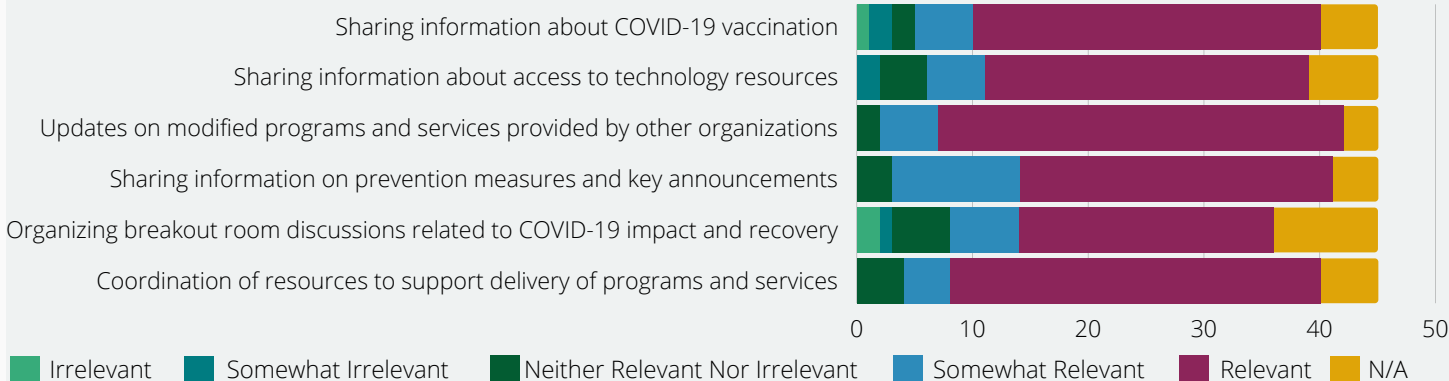

RELEVANCY OF COVID RESPONSE



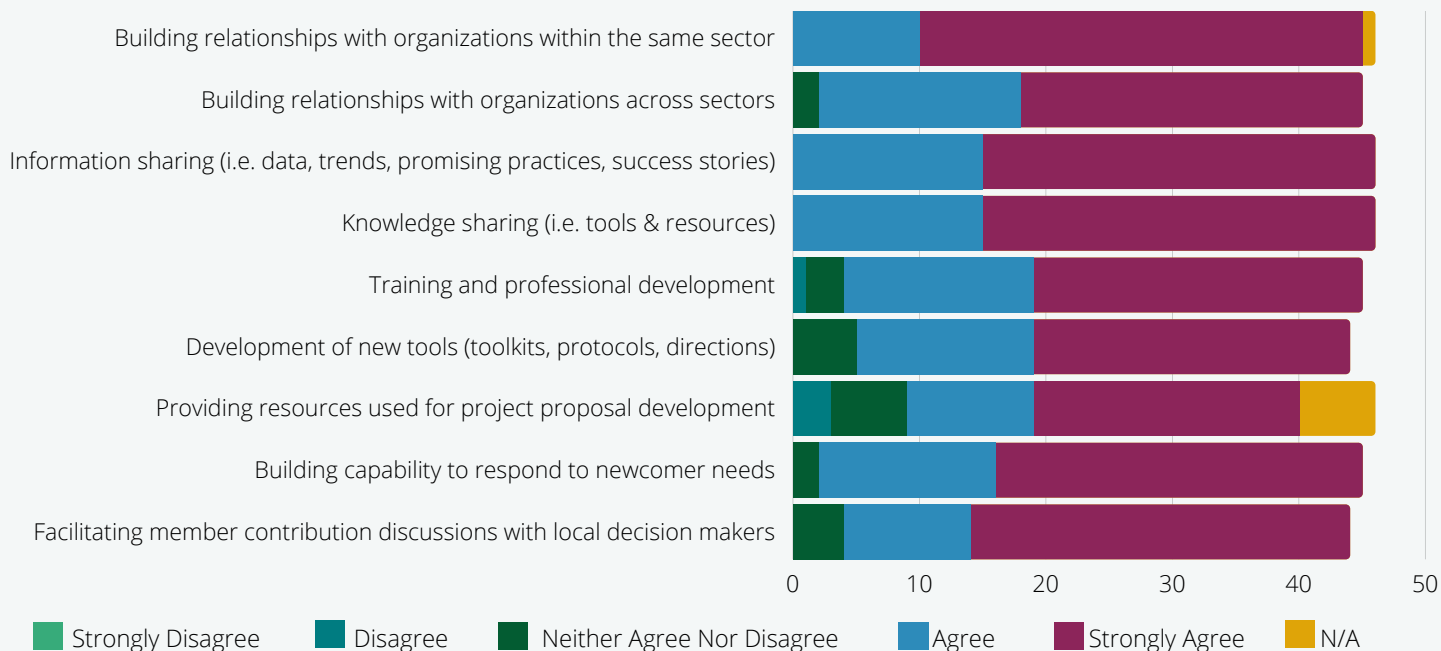

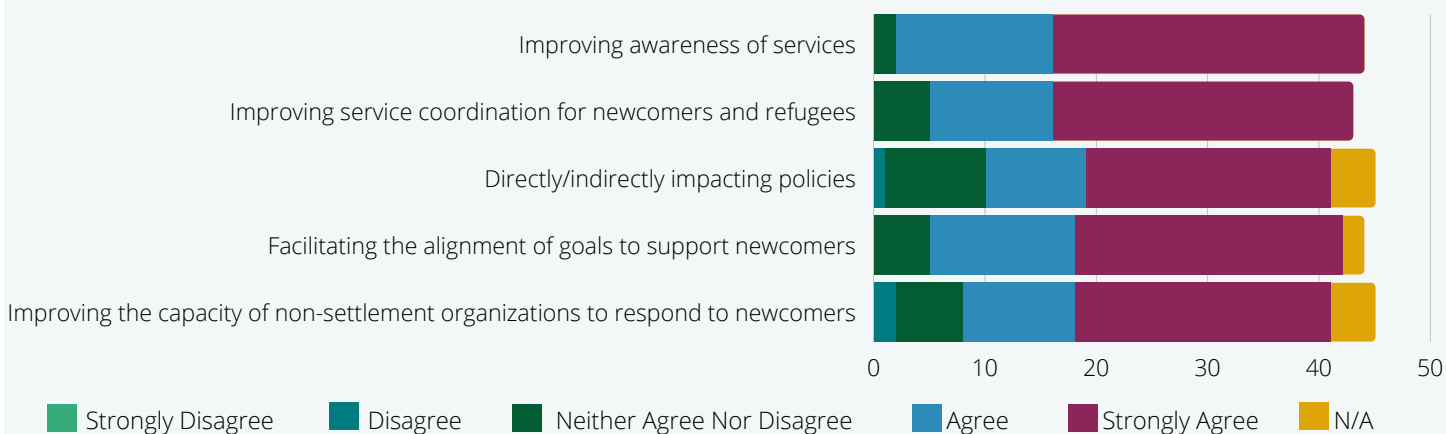

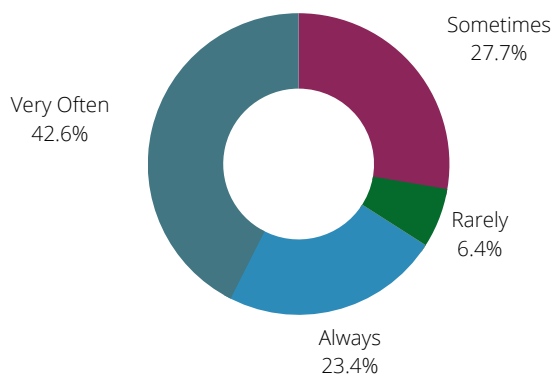
TNLIP is Helpful in...

How often do you share TNLIP resources with colleagues?

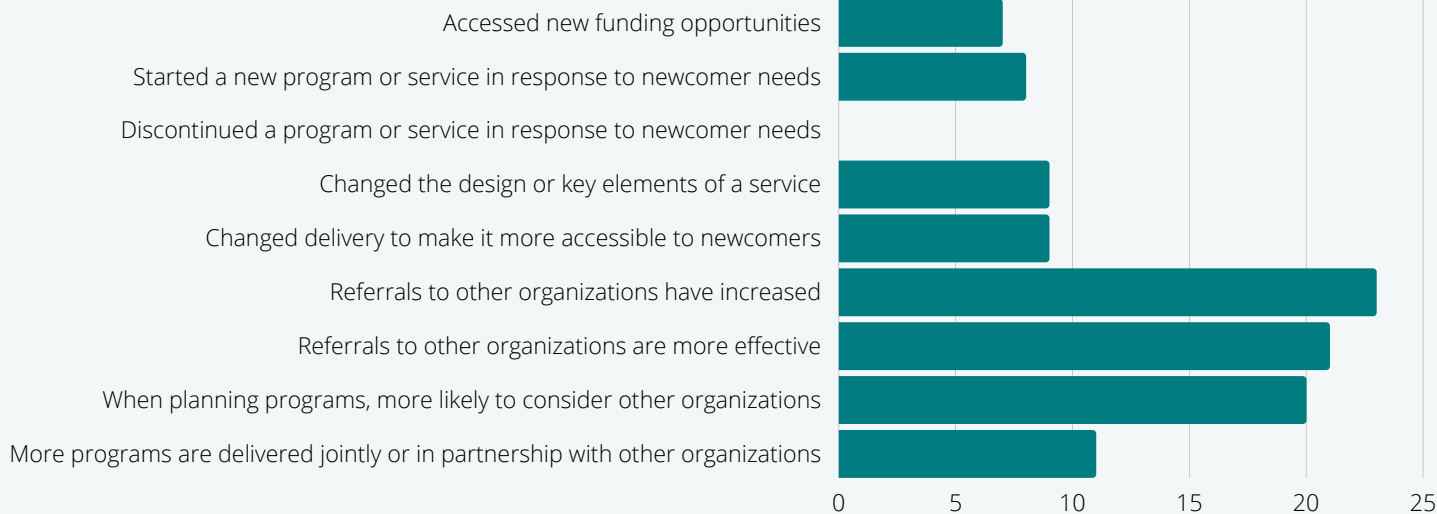


MEMBERSHIP COLLABORATIONS

WHAT HAVE WE BEEN ACCOMPLISHING TOGETHER?

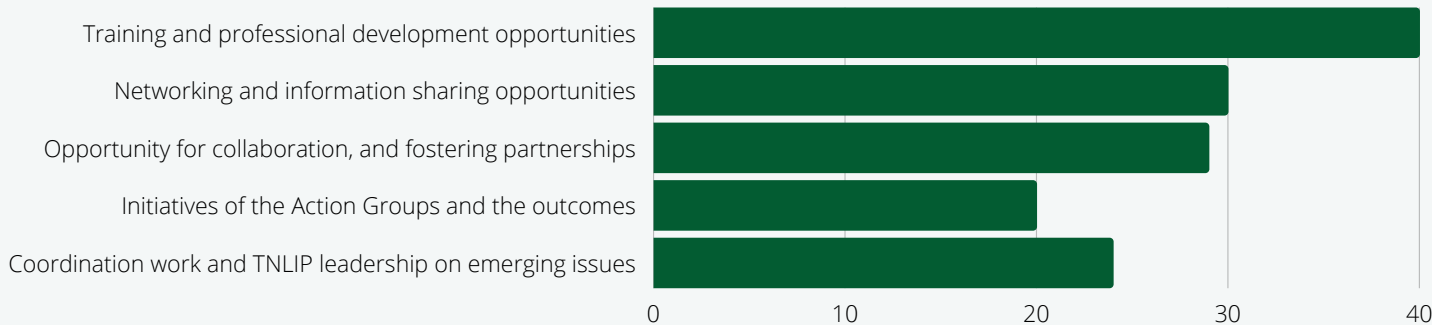
